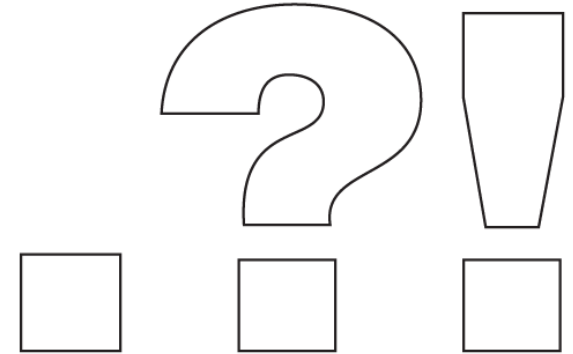


# Interrogative



# 4 Corners

1. Hang banners in each corner of the room
  2. Students choose a corner to stand at
  3. Teacher reads a sentence
  4. If students think it is the sentence where they are standing (corner), they sit down
  5. If students are wrong they are out of the game
  6. Students who are correct get a sticker
- Teacher reads 10 sentences. Student with the most stickers is the Sentence Champ!

## Practice Examples
