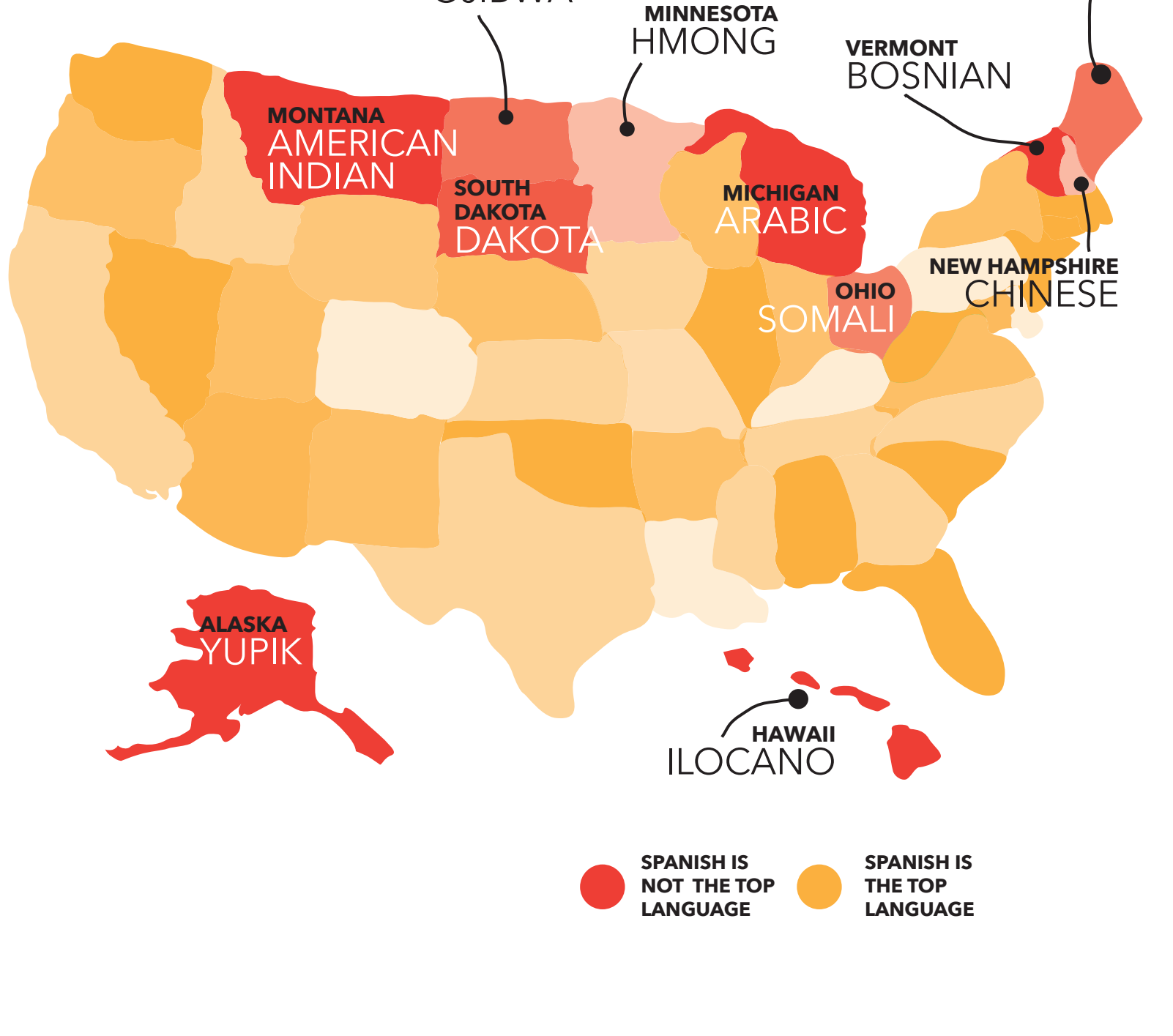

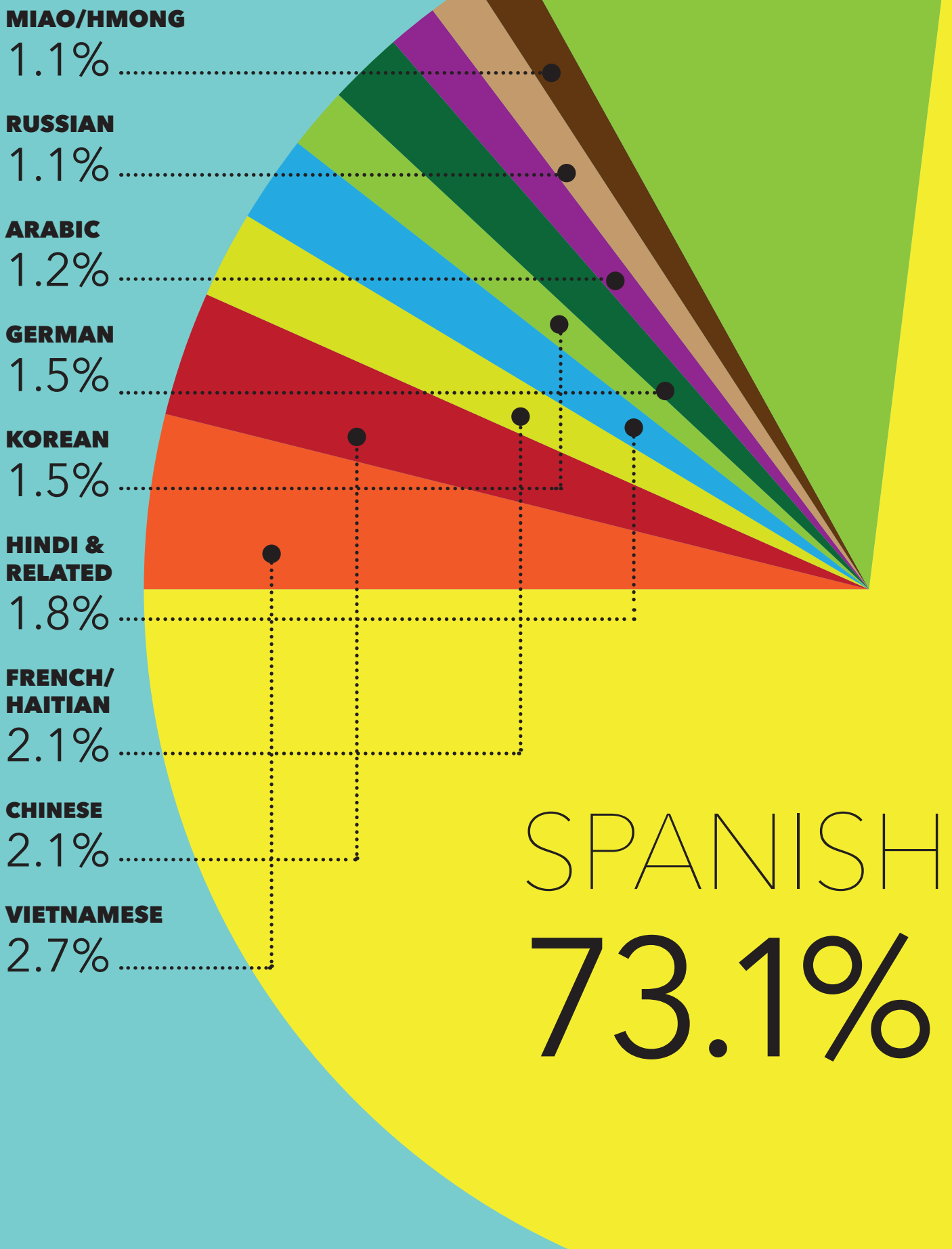
SPANISH ISN'T ALWAYS #1

While Spanish is spoken by 73.1 percent of the 4.6 million ELLs in the United States, it's not the top second language in every state. Here's a breakdown.



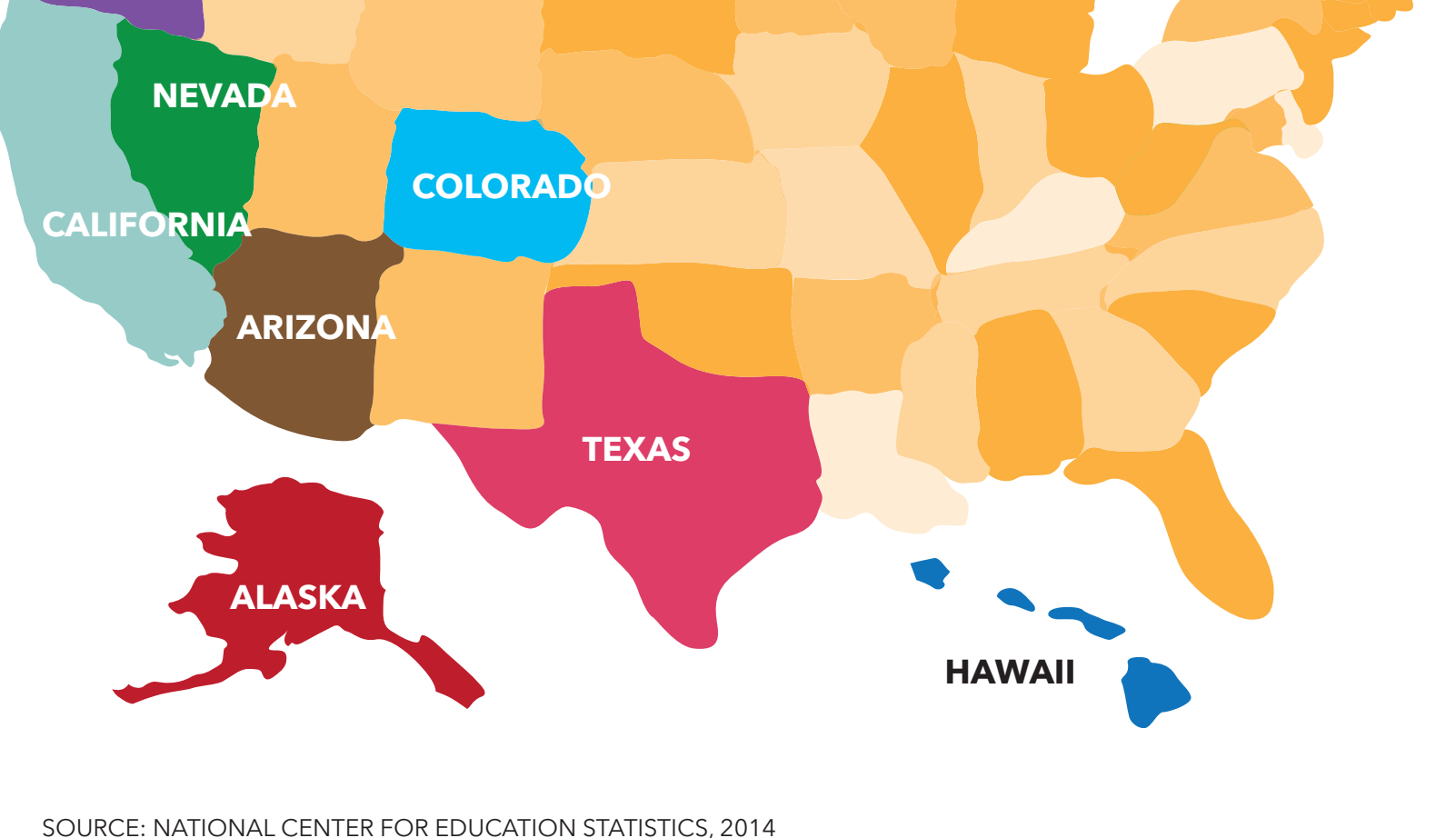

TOP 10 LANGUAGES SPOKEN IN ELL HOMES



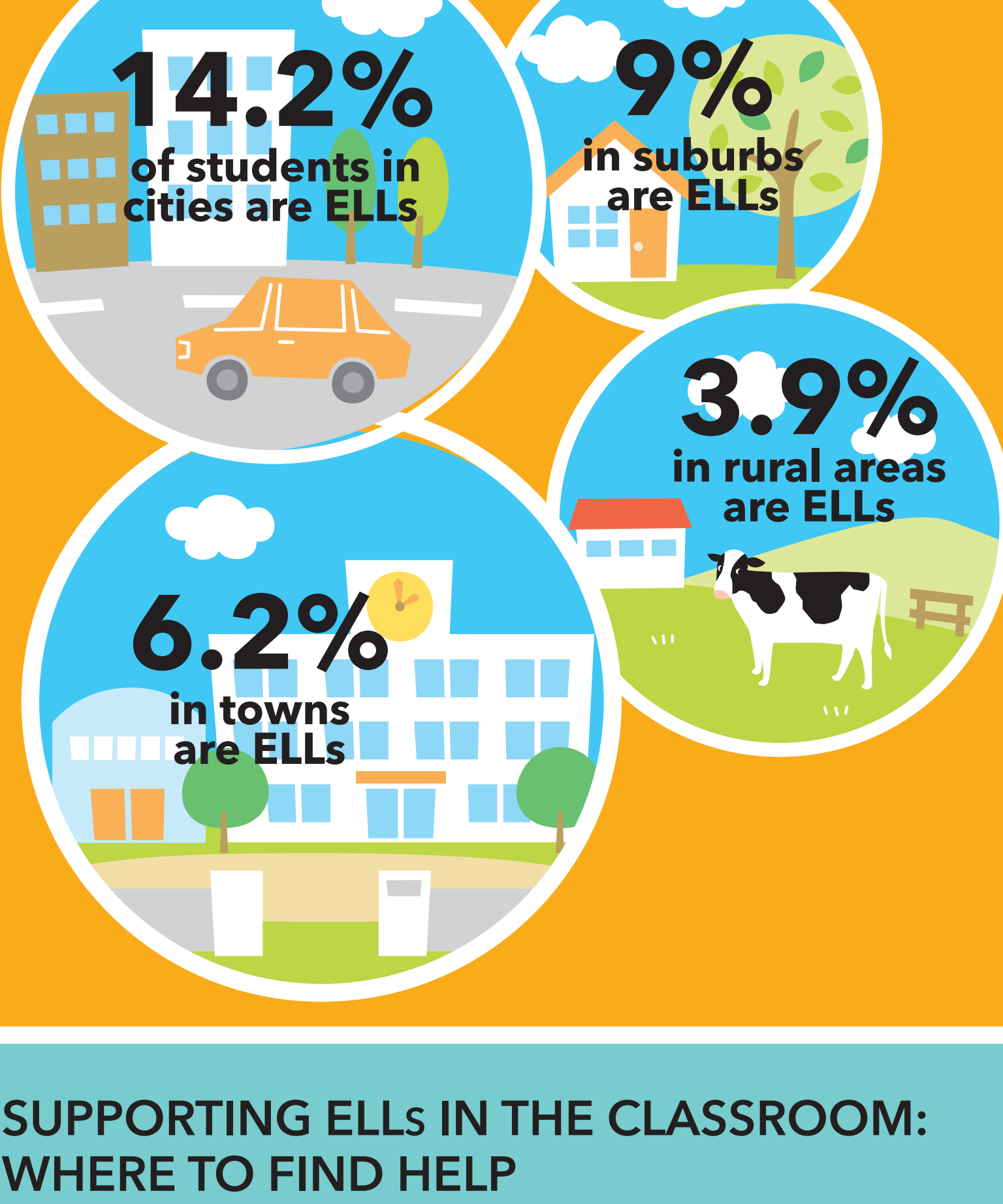
